Invitation to a community open day for the proposed Loch Toftingall Wind Farm.

Infinergy, a Boralex Company, is developing a proposal for Loch Toftingall Wind Farm. This is a wind energy development comprising 2 wind turbines to a maximum 149.9m to tip and a 40MW battery energy storage system. The site is located to the west of Loch Toftingall, north of the operational Halsary Wind Farm on the A9 south of Spittal.

Utilising the natural environment to harness clean, zero carbon energy, the project will, if consented, support local jobs and employment during its construction and operation. It will also offer community benefit and shared ownership opportunities, and support the long-term management of the land and the ambitions of the country for renewable energy generation.
